

PŘÍSLOVCE SO, SUCH

Použití SO, SUCH (tak, takový):

SO	+	přídavné jméno, příslovce
SUCH	+	(a/an) + (přídavné jméno) + podstatné jméno

so stupid	such a story	I didn't enjoy the book.
so nice	such a stupid story	The story was so stupid.
so quick	such nice people	It was such a stupid story.
so quickly	such good advice	The film was so long.
so many		It was such a long film.

▪ **SO a SUCH zesilují význam přídavného jména nebo příslovce:**

- It's a lovely day, isn't it? It's **so warm**. (= really warm)
- He is difficult to understand because he speaks **so quickly**.
- We enjoyed our holiday. We had **such a good** time. (= a really good time)
- I like Tom and Ann. They are **so nice**.
- I like Tom and Ann. They are **such nice** people.

▪ **Vazby se SO a SUCH jsou často doplněny vedlejší větou s THAT (že):**

- The book was **so good that** I couldn't put it down.
- I was **so tired that** I fell asleep in the armchair.
- I was **so tired that** I had to go to bed.
- It was **such a good book that** I couldn't put it down.
- It was **such lovely weather that** we spent the whole day on the beach.
- It was **such a great experience that** I will do it again.

▪ **SO a SUCH používáme také ve významu „like this“ - takhle, takovýchle:**

- I was surprised to find out that the house was built 100 years ago.
I didn't realise it was **so old**. (as old as it is).
I didn't realise it was **such an old house**.
- I expected the weather to be much cooler.
I didn't expect it to be **so warm**.
- I am tired because I got up at 6 o'clock.
I don't usually get up **so early**.
- The house was **so untidy**.
I have never seen **such a mess**. (= a mess like this)

▪ **Další použití SO a SUCH:**

so long I haven't seen her for so long.	such a long time I haven't seen her for such a long time.
so far I didn't know it was so far.	such a long way I didn't know it was such a long way.
so much, so many Why did you buy so much food?	such a lot (of) Why did you buy such a lot of food?
